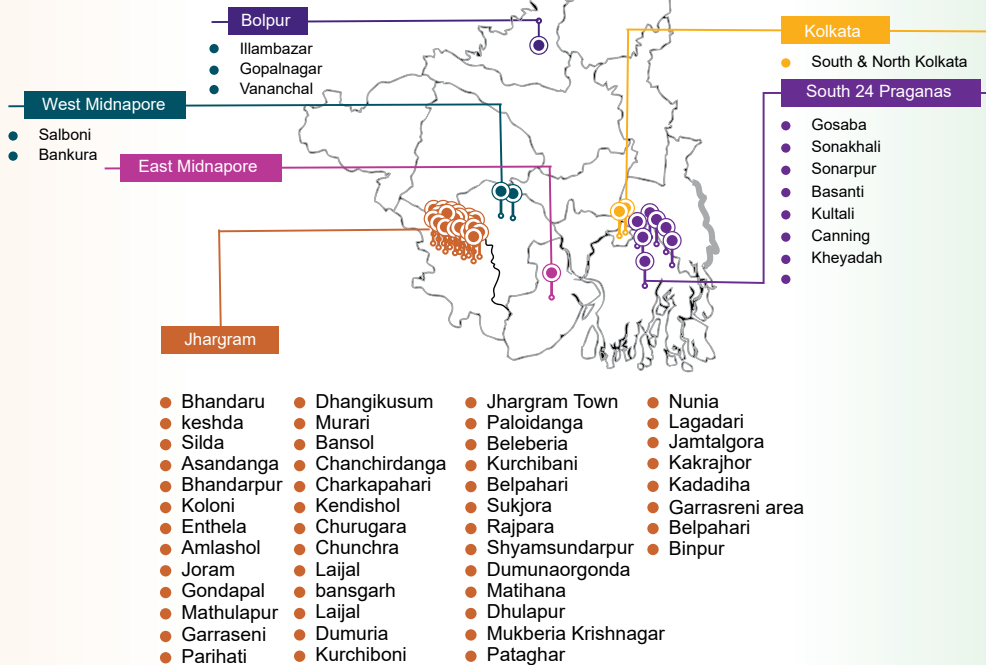

In Jhargram: 2 Oxygen Concentrator used in interior Tribal belts of the district. These were the first two Oxygen concentrators to reach the district and to be used there. 1 Oxygen Concentrator - supplied for use by BJP workers in West Midnapore - Tribal belt

In three phases during Covid: distributed: ration kits, masks, sanitiser, medicines, Oxymeter to villages in Belpahari and Binpur, Jhargram, West Midnapore's Salboni & Bankura.

Jhargram, West Midnapore - Salboni, Bankura - 60 Covid patients were supplied medicine and meals three times a day for two months.

Amlasole: June, July & August 2021 - in three phases: Ration Kit (1 month's supply) (June, July, August), Dresses - for women, men and children (August)

Kankrajhor - Belpahari - Dist Jhargram: Ration (1 month's supply) August for 80 families

Kolkata South & North: 2 Oxygen Concentrators, mask and sanitisers distributed.

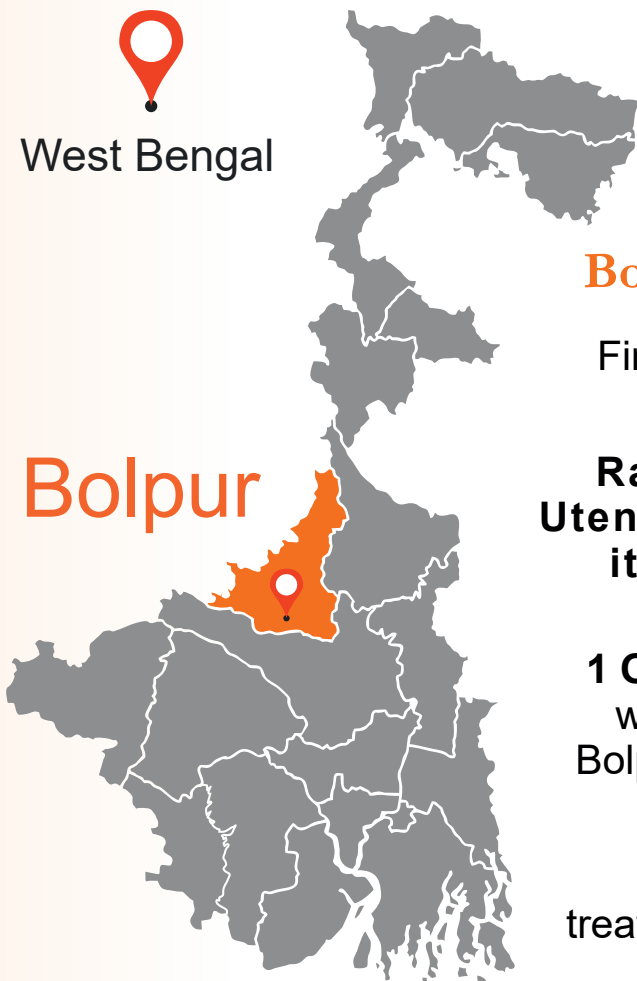

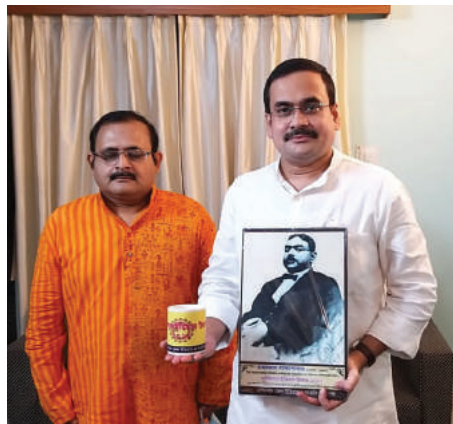
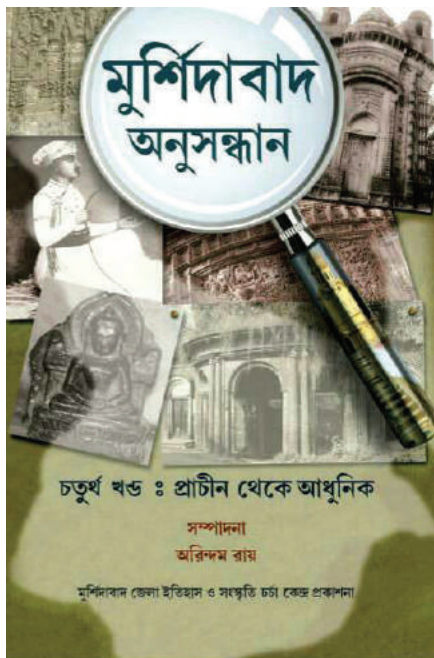
18 September 2021

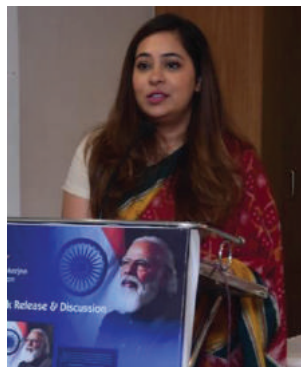
